## Overview

Thank you for being an online viewer of this videoconference. In order to view this conference you will need to have the following software configured on your system:

- a 28k modem or higher (for audio/video) or high speed Internet access via a T1 line or LAN
- a set of speakers and a sound card

## Reception Issues

This cybercast will be sent out in 3 streams: 28k, 56k and 100k. The greater bandwidth you have, the better the picture will be. If you are viewing at a lower bandwidth, you may notice that the picture stops or “buffers”. This is normal and the video should begin playing on it’s own in a short time.
